



AUVA Equipment Isolators

Installation Guide

Disclaimer

The installation of the Stack Audio AUVA EQ involves modifying the placement of your HiFi equipment. For larger and heavier HiFi components like power amplifiers, we advise installation of the EQs with someone on hand to help you with lifting and positioning. Improper installation of the EQ isolator could result in damage to your equipment, floor, or other nearby objects. It is the responsibility of the user to properly install the isolator and ensure that the HiFi components are secure and stable. Please consider the weight and size of your equipment when selecting the appropriate isolator. Unplug all HiFi before attempting installation to avoid the risk of electric shock or damage to equipment.

If the feet of your HiFi are not easily removable and doing so would involve taking your HiFi apart, we recommend avoiding this process as it may void the manufacturer's warranty or cause damage to your equipment.

The effectiveness of the isolator may vary depending on the surface it is placed on, the weight of HiFi equipment, and the listening room environment.

Stack Audio is not liable for any damage or injury that may occur as a result of the installation or use of the product. By installing the AUVA EQ isolator, you acknowledge and accept the risks and responsibilities associated with modifying your HiFi setup. It is important to have read your HiFi equipment manufacturer's instructions and the Stack Audio EQ installation instructions before beginning.

Note

The manufacturing process is critical to the performance of the AUVA EQs. The outer shell is precision-machined from a solid billet of aluminium with a durable anodized finish. The internal cells containing the particles in the isolator are precisely made and tested to tight tolerances to ensure they perform as expected and the Custom Silicone inserts have been designed and specifically optimized for different weights of equipment, ensure that you only use Equipment within the specs of the CSA insert that you have chosen.

Do not attempt to clean the outside of the AUVAs with solvent or acetone cleaning solutions. Any attempt to do so will invalidate the warranty.

Installation

1. Ensure a stable surface & that HiFi is disconnected: Before installing the AUVA HiFi isolators, ensure that your shelf or rack is stable and capable of supporting the weight of your HiFi equipment, make sure that all HiFi is disconnected from the power before installation.
2. Positioning the isolators: Place the AUVA HiFi isolators on the shelf or rack in the desired locations where you plan to position your HiFi equipment. The isolators should be positioned in a way that evenly distributes the weight of the equipment.
3. Rubber disks for added friction: Install the EQ Isolators without applying the rubber disks where possible. The rubber disks are supplied to create added friction when pairing the EQs with HiFi. If you notice movement between the isolator and the case when using your HiFi it may be a good idea to use the rubber discs for added friction.
4. Placing your HiFi equipment: Gently place your HiFi equipment on top of the AUVA isolators, ensure that there is still enough room between the top of your HiFi and your shelf or rack to cool off, if applicable. (Consult your HiFi guide)
5. Check stability: After placing your HiFi equipment on the isolators, make sure that everything is stable and well-balanced. Ensure that the equipment is not tilting or leaning excessively.
6. Level adjustments (if applicable): If your HiFi equipment appears to tilt or be unstable once you have positioned it; adjust using the CSA insert. Each CSA insert has a small margin of height adjustment (2mm); loosen by a maximum of two counter-clockwise turns.
7. Enjoy enhanced HiFi performance: With the EQs in place, you can now enjoy improved sound quality and reduced vibrations, leading to an enhanced listening experience.
